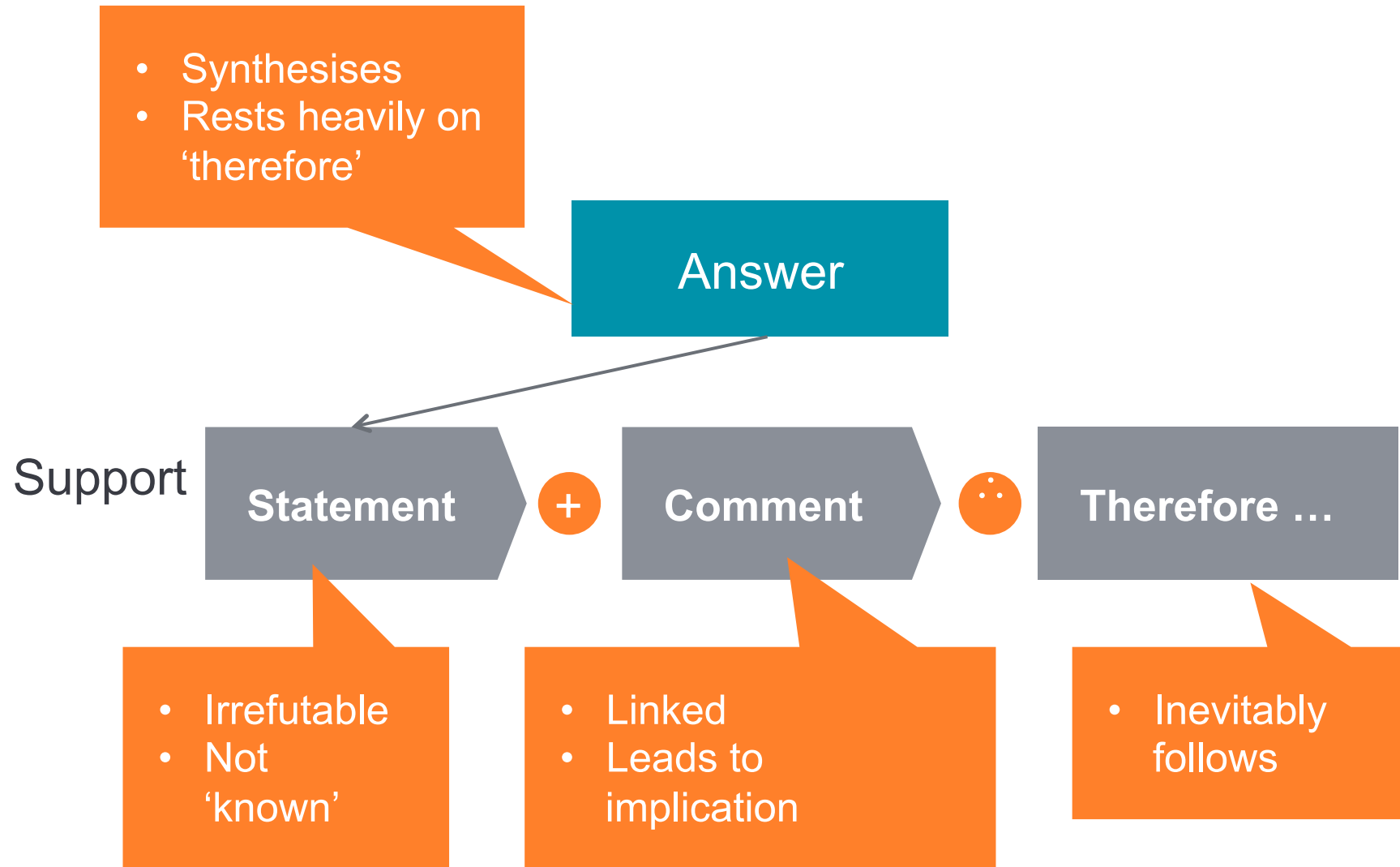

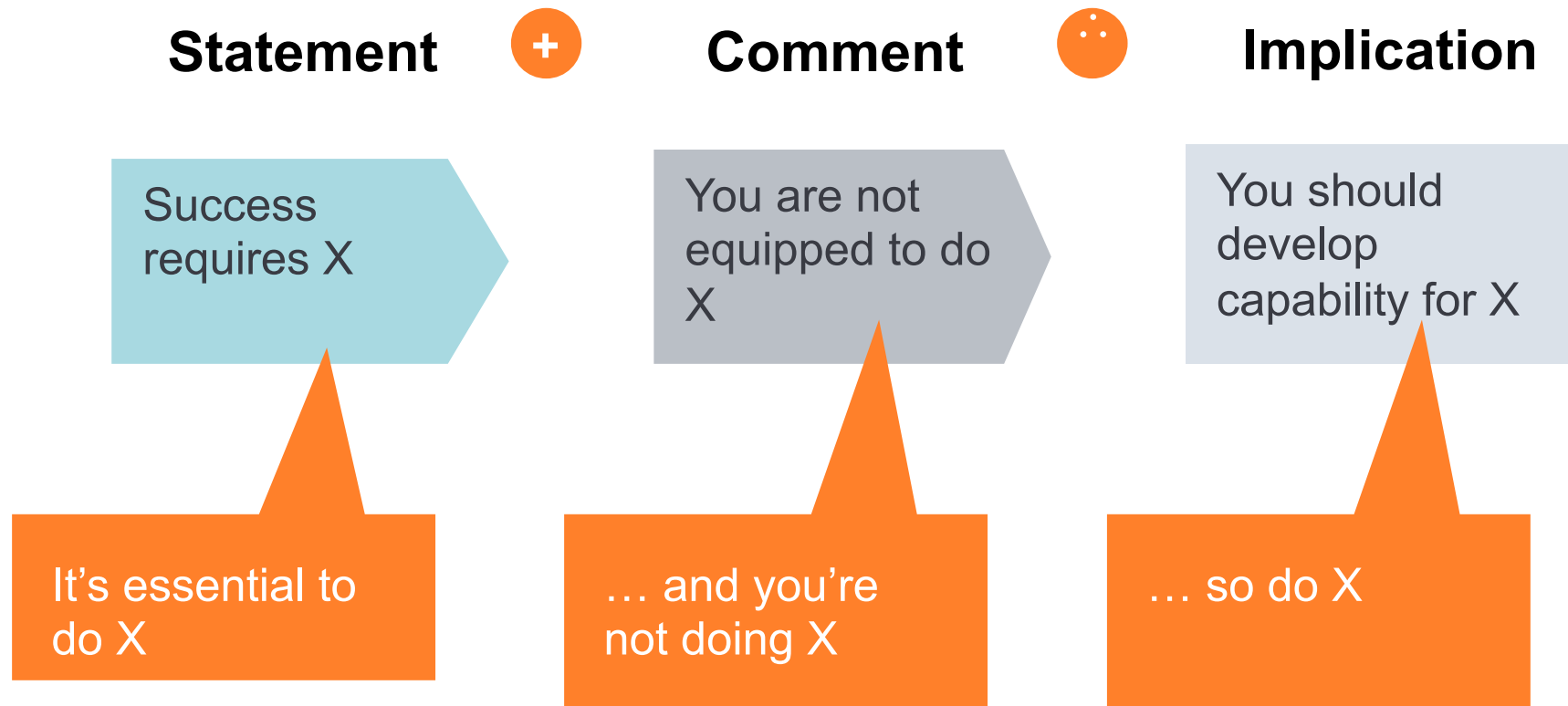

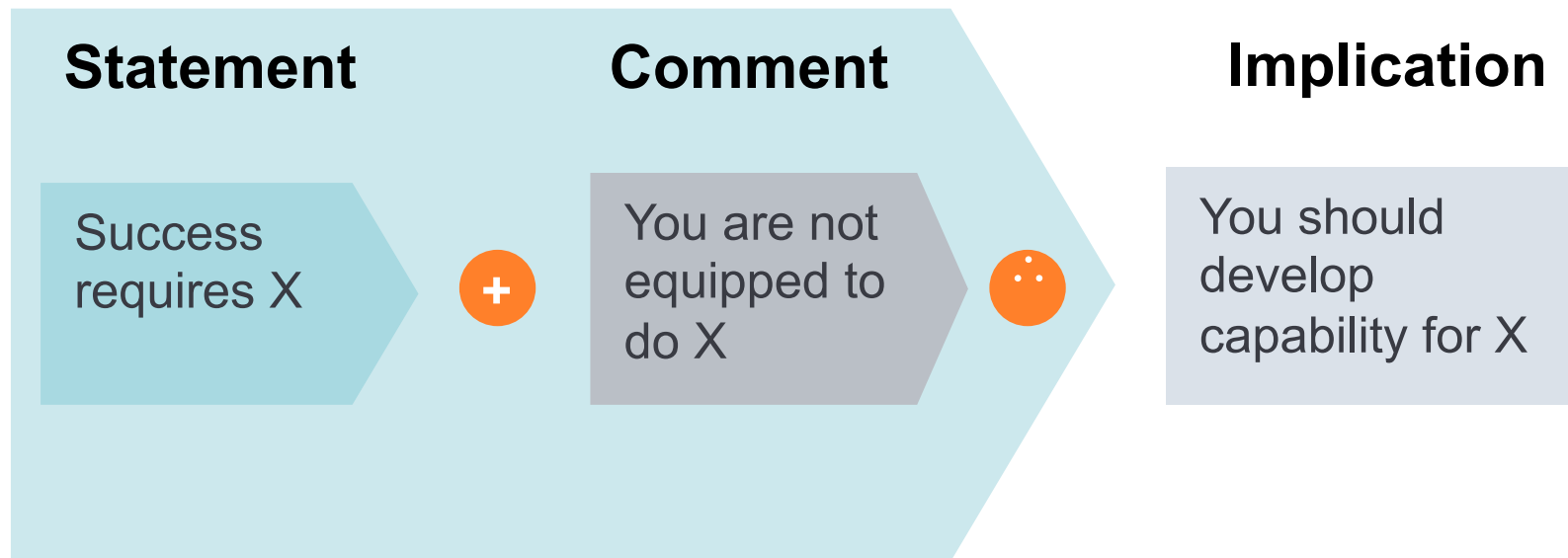
# The argument must be true in both form and fact



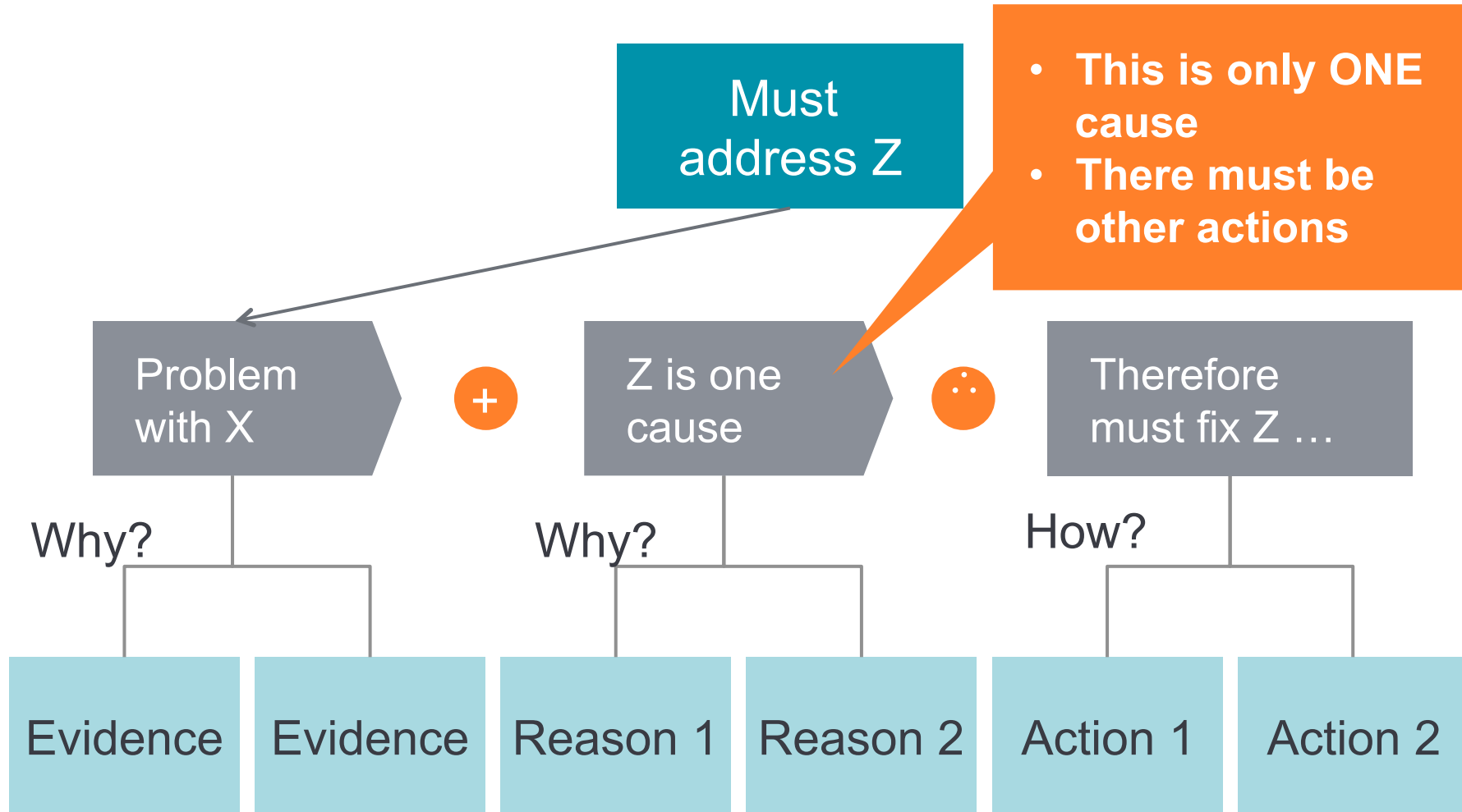
# This option is tight



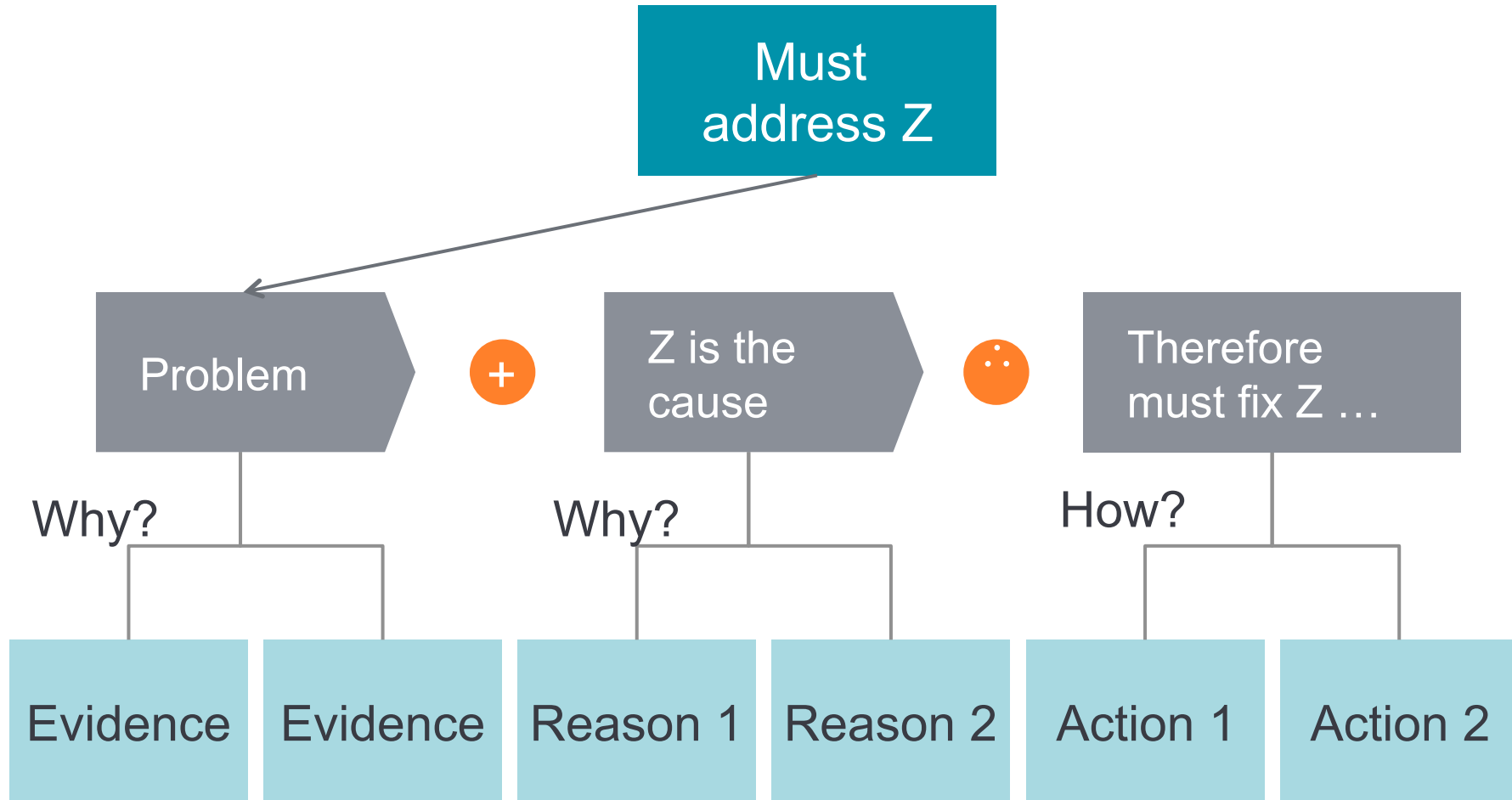
# The statement and the comment must lead to the implication



# No: It is not tight enough

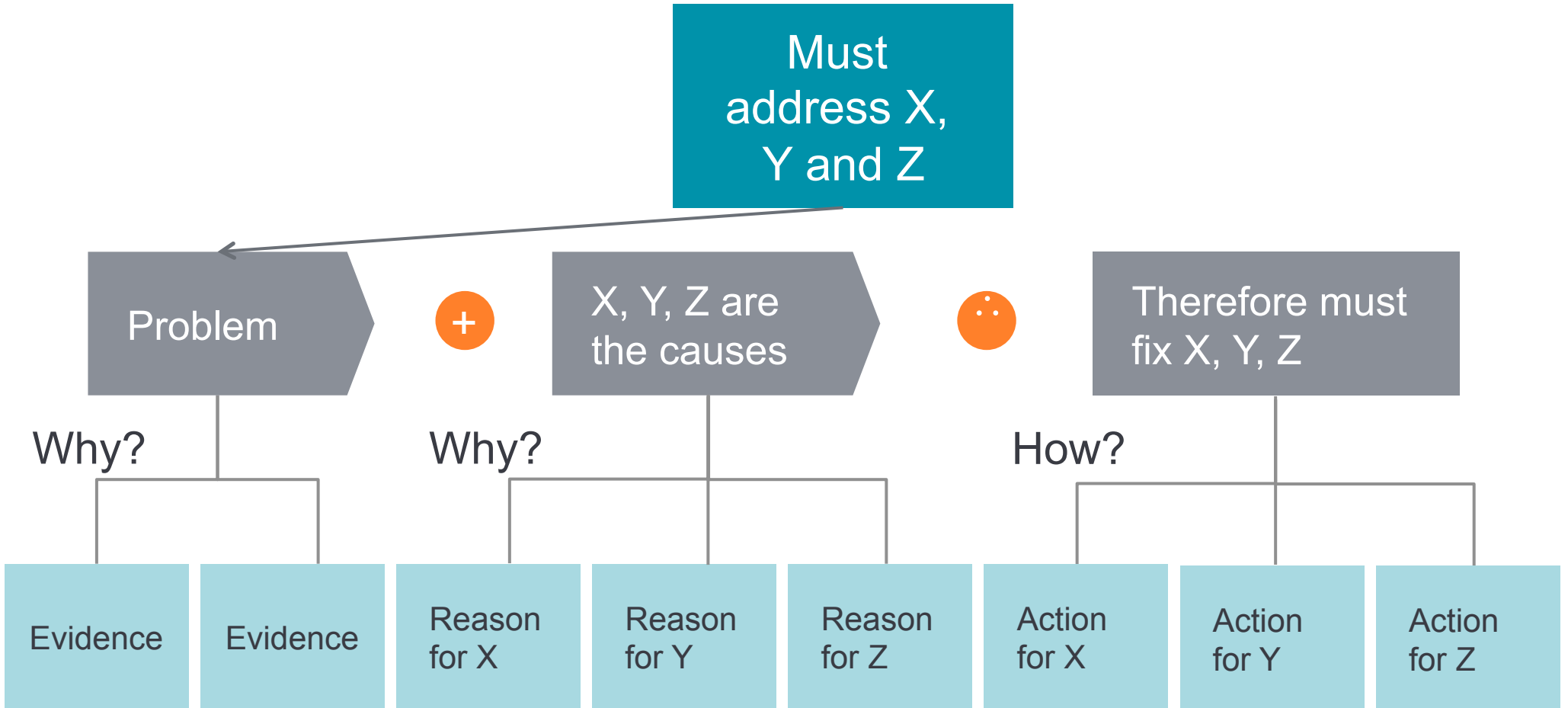


# This is tighter
